# High School Talking Points

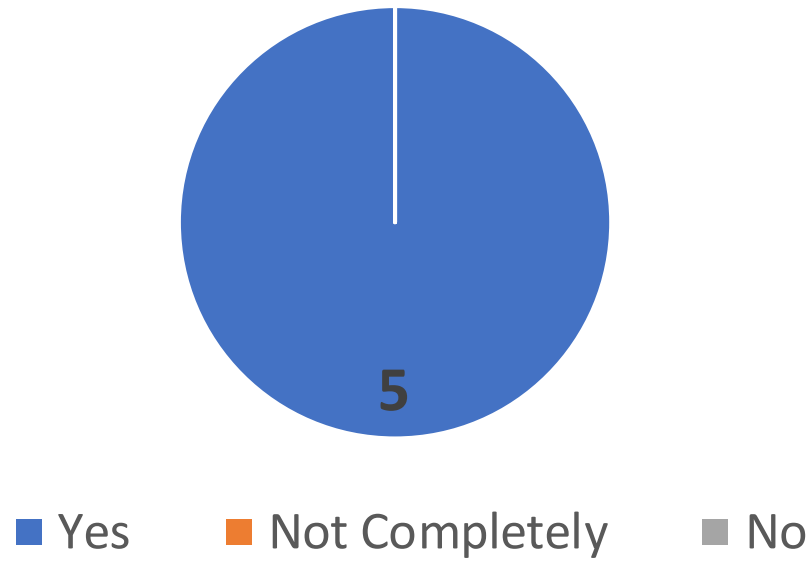
**Are there any concerns that have shown up for you and your student at the beginning of this school year?**

**Are there any concerns that have shown up for you and your student at the beginning of this school year?**

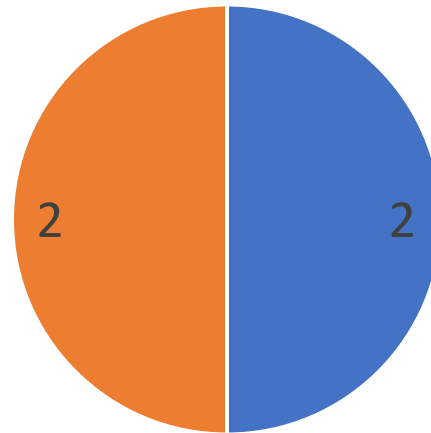
- We got a late start whole family has had a lot going on.
