K12 CODCA School Level Spelling Bee - January 27, 2023

- This competition will be virtual
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners advance to the Semi-Regional level
- Winners in all 3 grade bands will advance

#### K12 Semi-Regional Spelling Bee - February 2023

- This competition will be virtual
- Non- K12 students will compete at this level with K12 students
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners advance to the Regional level
- Winners in all 3 grade bands will advance

#### K12 Western Region Spelling Bee - March 2023

- This competition will be virtual
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners advance to the Regional level
- Winners in all 3 grade bands will advance to the national in-person competition

#### K12 National Spelling Bee - June 2023

- This competition will be in-person in Virginia
- Regional grade level winners will compete in person at K12 headquarters in Herndon, Virginia
- K12 will pay for the hotel and flight accommodations for the participant and one chaperone.

## **Non-discrimination Statement**
